

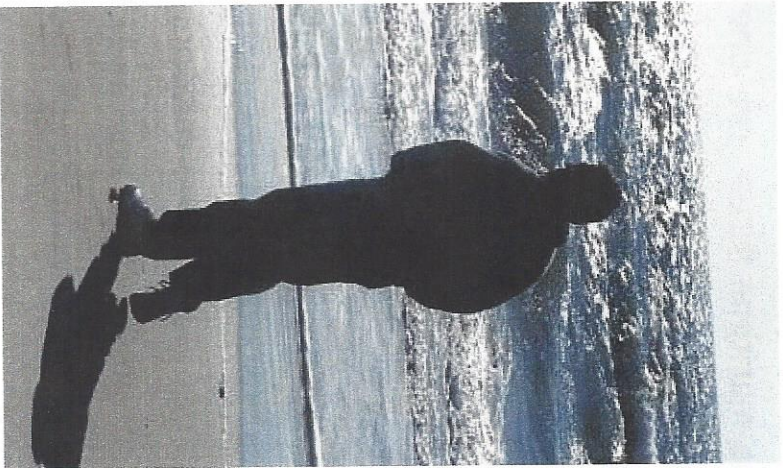

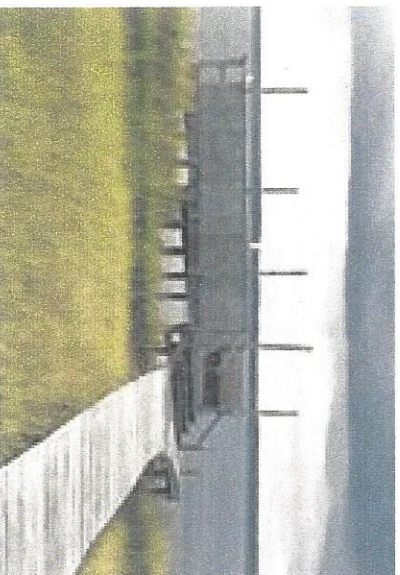

About Trinity Center

Trinity Center, nestled in a pristine maritime forest on one of North Carolina's barrier islands, extends from Bogue Sound to the Atlantic Ocean. A mild climate and award-winning landscaping, designed with sensitivity to the island environment, provide peaceful and restful surroundings. Recreational facilities include two outdoor swimming pools as well as 1/3 mile of oceanfront Beach and Sound.

Travel to Trinity Center

Trinity is approximately a four-hour drive from the Raleigh-Durham airport. There are closer airports in Wilmington NC (about an hour from Trinity) and Jacksonville NC (about 30 minutes from Trinity), but they are smaller and would involve higher airfares. We are working on the possibility of providing van shuttle service from Raleigh to Trinity.

Anticipated Costs:

The cost of the Colloquium will be comparable to the ones held in Canada and Texas and will include three nights accommodation (double occupancy), meals, and conference fees. In line with NGTLC tradition, costs will be kept down by offering neither honoraria nor travel expenses.
