

Great Teachers in the Canadian Rockies (June 2012)

The National Great Teachers Seminar in the Canadian Rockies was held again this June in Banff, Alberta. Sponsored by MacEwan University, the seminar successfully celebrated its 27th year. Post-secondary educators from Alberta and British Columbia institutions, including MacEwan, Kwantlen University, Red Deer College, SAIT, and Lakeland College met for a week at the Banff Centre, whose mission is, appropriately, "Inspiring Creativity". Teachers shared teaching innovations and solutions to teaching challenges, and discussed a number of topics related to great teaching practices. The seminar adhered to the principles and premises of David Gottshall's model, and it was well directed this year by Judy Koch of MacEwan University.
