Great Teachers Meet in the Canadian Rockies June 2019



The 34^{th} National Great Teachers Seminar in the Canadian Rockies was held from June $2-6^{th}$ in Banff, Alberta Canada. University and college instructors from Alberta, Manitoba and Wisconsin met to explore the universals of great teaching, share teaching innovations, and discuss solutions to teaching challenges.

The annual seminar is held at the Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity, a state of the art facility which hosts meetings and conferences from around the world. The administrative coordination for the Great Teachers Seminar is handled through the Office of Teaching and Learning Services at MacEwan University in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.

In the past, the seminar was led for 26 years by David Gottshall, founder of the Great Teachers Movement, and this year's seminar was again capably directed by Judy Koch, of MacEwan University. Like the Hawaii Great Teachers Seminar, the *National Great Teachers Seminar in the Canadian Rockies* is an open-registration seminar, inviting registrations from any post-secondary teaching faculty member.
